

Declaration of Conformity to EU WEEE

The Directive 2002/96/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 January 2003 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) came into force on February 13, 2005, and have been transposed into national law by the EU member states. The EU Directive 2002/96/EU was created to improve the collection and recycling of WEEE throughout the EU, and to reduce the level of non-recycled waste. Directive 2002/96/EU has been repealed with effect from 15 February 2014 and replaced by Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).
